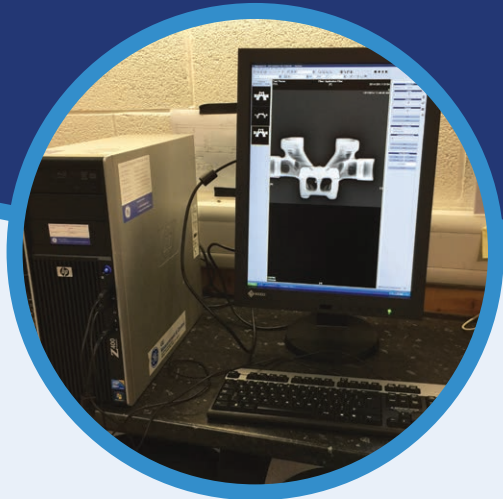




ITCL: Ready for Inspection Digital Radiography



What is it?

Digital Radiography is one of the newest forms of radiographic testing. Since no film is required, digital radiographic images are captured using either special phosphor screens or flat panels containing micro-electronic sensors. Captured images can be digitally enhanced for increased detail and are easily archived.

ITCL carry out two forms of digital radiographic imaging including:

Computed Radiography (CR): digital imaging process that uses a special imaging plate which employs storage phosphors.

Direct Radiography (DR): a form of real-time radiography that uses a special flat panel detector.

ITCL employ both of the above digital radiographic systems to provide the following radiographic services.
